I have known Anne Asensio since 2010 and have followed her career with great interest and admiration. She not only holds a senior position as VP of Design with Dassault Systèmes but commands the support and respect of the head of the company. I know because I have experienced her interactions with Bernard Charlès.

More importantly, she is a long-time supporter of WDO and understands the history and role of the organization. Her work on developing sustainability as a core foundation of Dassault Systèmes as well as her own work puts her at the forefront of designers across the world. It is not a coincidence that Dassault Systèmes was an Associate Sponsor of the "Waste Age" exhibit at the London Design Museum, where the huge pendant that hung in the opening hall was created by Mamou-Mani Architects and the Dassault Systèmes Design Studio. The pendant, Aurora, "signals the end of the take-make-waste era" according to its designers and uses PLA plastics and wood pulp to show how a new building material might be conceived. As she says in her position statement:

The future will be about empowering designers in their transformative projects with meaningful resources, creation of a center of excellence and accessible knowledge for the WDO design community—thus fulfilling the UN Sustainable Development Goals promise.

WDO is an important organization. It is not yet well known enough, even within the design community. Designers need to develop design methods that respect the environment, using new materials, new means of manufacturing, and designing for repair, upgrading, and enhancements. The new technological changes, especially generative models from AI, promise to cause radical changes in the jobs of designers. WDO needs someone who can help make these transitions.

Anne has been a highly skilled designer at numerous companies, a senior executive at one of the world's largest companies, and a strong board member at WDO. As the world faces many major transformations today, Anne is well equipped to lead WDO, the design profession, and the world in dealing with the complexity of the transition to the circular economy and the resulting changes in design practice and. business models, as well as to the changes in the design practices themselves as Al becomes more an more ingrained into design tools.


